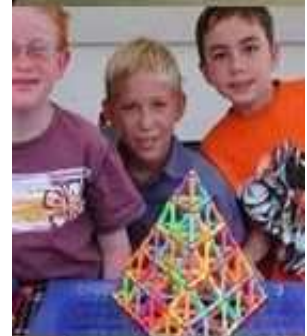
This two-day conference features inspiring speakers for the children with their parents followed by a full afternoon of fantastic fun children's workshops and separate seminars for parents.
